Bovis Lend Lease acted as Construction Manager for the building of a luxurious, 265-room hotel, underground car park, infrastructures and services, as well as the landscaping of the plaza. The project also included the remodelling of the old Cordoba Train Station, converting it into a shopping centre. The total built surface area was over 49,000 m².

The project was carried out during the Expo'92 with the inevitable organisation and resource difficulties. The 70 subcontractors working under Bovis Lend Lease's management completed the construction, however, with a 7% saving over the original budget and 6 months ahead of schedule.

The Project awarded The Architecture Award in 1992.
